## Talks and Wine Tastings

**All tours and tastings must be booked in advance**

### **Artist Talk - Provided by one of the exhibiting artists**

25 minute talk seated, followed by 35 minute guided tour to selected exhibits. Guests can then stroll through the exhibition on their own before re-joining their party for refreshments (see over).

The ground is fairly flat around the vineyard but please wear sensible shoes as there may be uneven patches.

**£8 per person (minimum booking for 12 people).**

### **Wine Tasting with Wines by Bothy Vineyard**



The tour will start with a short talk about the history of the vineyard, the economics of such a modest business, viticulture and the environmental factors which affect our harvest and wine.

Then the party is taken to the winery where wine-making operations are explained and the equipment displayed. Finally we provide a tasting of our award-winning wines with a few nibbles, most probably cheese and biscuits. This takes around 1 hour depending on the interests of the group.

In addition to the tasting, additional wine can be bought by the glass or by the bottle after the tour
